




Nuns reading Maitreya's ornaments for clear realization and Supplement to the middle way.








HIS Holiness the XIVth Dalai Lama, Tenzin Gyatso, is the spiritual guru for all of us. He was born in a small village called Taktser in northeastern Tibet. Born to a peasant family, His Holiness was recognized at the age of two, in accordance with Tibetan tradition, as the reincarnation of his predecessor the 13th Dalai Lama. The Dalai Lamas are the manifestations of the Bodhisattva of Compassion, who chose to reincarnate to serve the people. Dalai Lama means Ocean of Wisdom. Tibetans normally refer to His Holiness as *Yeshin Norbu*, the Wish-fulfilling Gem, or simply, *Kundun*, meaning The Presence.

*** LAMA TSONG -KHAPA DAY!**

Ganden Ngamchoe, literally means "Ganden Offering of the Twenty-Fifth Day," or Lama Tsong -khapa Day, is a celebration of the anniversary of Lama Tsongkhapa's parinirvana. It is celebrated on the twenty-fifth day of the tenth month of the Tibetan calendar which falled on 18th December this year.

Jangchub choeling nuns recited the (Lekshe Nyingpo) "The Essence of Eloquence," by Tsong Khapa and perfomed guru puja and lighted whole nunnery in lamps while chanting MIKTSEMA in the evening.

■ Year 2 Research Methodology Training was also held there for nuns and monks from various monasteries. Our two nuns attended this training from December 9 to 22th, 2022.






Holly Jolly Christmas
